Computing is mostly made up of these five areas:

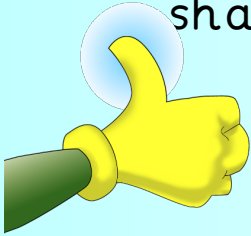

What is a consequence?

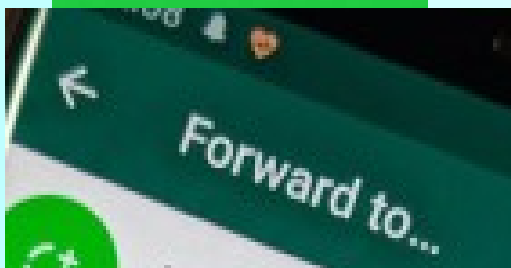
What does consequence

## How do you choose whether to share something online or not?

Will I feel good or different about it later?

A split second of rage can have permanent consequences.

Why am I posting?

Don't follow the crowd or post just to gain attention, as you might not like the response you get back.

Would I say this in person?

No? Then don't say it online.

Can this be interpreted differently?

Sarcasm does not often transfer well into writing, especially in a short social media post. Think about how others may read it; could it be seen as rude or offensive?

Am I being kind?

Treat others with the respect that you would like to receive yourself.

Is it private?

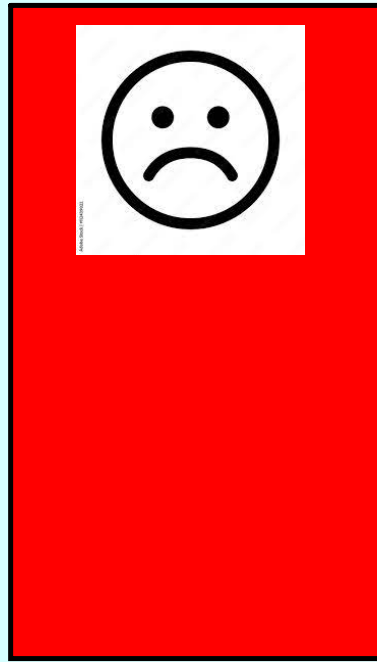
Consider how many connections you have, are all these people very close friends? Can you trust that each one of them won't share or talk about your post with others?

Do I have permission?

Be respectful of other people's privacy; don't share photos or information that will embarrass or humiliate someone else.

Would I like me?

If most of your posts are in some way critical, unkind, offensive or negative, how do you think you are other people think about you?
